



# 2017 Southeastern Regional Dragon Boat Association Championships June 3, 2017 – Nathan Benderson Park, Sarasota FL

# Bulletin #1

Welcome to the first of three bulletins you will receive regarding participation in the **2017 Southeastern Regional Dragon Boat Association** (SRDBA) Championships. In this bulletin you will find information on the venue, racing equipment, racing classes, club eligibility, racing schedule, hotel accommodation, race fees and how to submit your provisional entries including important deadlines.

## Venue – Nathan Benderson Park, SARASOTA, FL

Nathan Benderson Park is a Suncoast Region, Florida park located adjacent to Interstate 75 at University Parkway in Sarasota, FL. The fresh water lake is a purpose built, Olympic class venue featuring 2000m of 8 x 13.5m lanes at 3.5m deep. The regatta course is well sheltered from crosswinds, has attenuated shorelines to dissipate wash and allows no access for commercial or pleasure boat traffic which could disrupt the competition.

## Racing Equipment – 2015/2016 Model 1222 by BuK

All SRDBA Championship races will take place in 2015 and/or 2016 Model BuK 1222 boats provided by Pan Am Dragon Boat. Each boat will be inspected prior to the competition to ensure they are properly matched.

SRDBA competitors must provide their own personal equipment such as paddles, PFD's and seat cushions. All personal equipment must be licensed by the relevant agency. Paddles must IDBF licensed with a visible PS202a mark including the license number. PFD's (optional) must be USCG approved. Inflatable PFD's are permitted but must be charged and worn properly in front of the torso. Seat cushions must meet IDBF regulations and compress to less than or equal to 1 cm.

#### **Racing Classes**

Age and gender rules for the SRDBA Championships mirror the rules set out in the IDBF Competition Regulations The following IDBF racing classes will be offered. Refer to the following list and the corresponding age/gender eligibility statement: (note: ">" means older than; "<" means younger than; "=" means equal to)

Notes: 1. For Junior and U-23 racing classes there is no restriction on age for the steersperson

2. For Senior A-B-C racing classes there is no restriction on age for the drummer.

3. Mixed crews must have an equal number of female and male paddlers on the racing roster.

#### **Club and Individual Competitor Eligibility**

Participation in the SRDBC is open to any member club and athletes within that club who are in good standing with the SRDBA. For information regarding SRDBA membership and to confirm your eligibility please visit www.srdba.org or contact the SRDBA secretary at secretary@srdba.org. Individual crews within clubs must race under their club banner and crew name identifier. All members of an SRDBA club are eligible to race on any crew within their club, notwithstanding age and gender restrictions listed above. An athlete may only race on a crew within their own club and may only race for one club.
